


Figure 1: Question: Do you think your child have rebellious emotion?




Figure 2: Question: In what way do you make decisions with your children in your family education?

Second, occasionally, they will be stipulated, but they will be given a certain place. Third option, to think and judge, let the children make all decisions by themselves. The results are shown.




Figure 3: Question: The way you treat your child when they make a mistake?
